Division 2 - Products

2.01 Standard Lockers:

- A. White melamine bodies consisting of 5/8" laminated particle board core for top, bottom, shelves and side, and 5/8" backs.
- B. Bodies are assembled using screws and glue.
 - 1. This assembly method provides both strength and durability.
- C. Single and double tier lockers include two clothing hooks per locker.
- D. Choice of padlock hasp or built-in key lock.

2.02 Door Handles & Latching:

- A. Doors consist of 5 1/8" industrial grade core with .030" plastic laminate finish in 4 standard colors. Door edges are radius edged and banded with black PVC edge banding.
- B. Three way adjustable concealed European hinges are standard on single tier lockers over 36" tall.
 - 1. Double tier, triple tier, and box lockers have two hinges per door.

2.03 ADA-Compliant Lockers:

- A. Single Tier Lockers:
 - 1. Hat shelf 48" maximum off the floor.
- B. Locker Bottom:
 - 1. Minimum of 9" off the floor, or an extra shelf placed 9" off the floor.
- C. Handicapped symbol attached to door.

2.04 Accessories Options:

- A. Number Plates:
 - 1. Include for each door
- B. Base:
 - 1. 4" black particle board core
- C. Locks:
 - 1. Additional lock options include:
 - A. Built-in combination lock, electronic locks, and coin locks
- D. Continuous Sloped Hoods:
 - 1. Four standard melamine colors with 3/4" particle board core.
- E. Finished End Panels:
 - 1. Four standard melamine colors with 3/4" particle board core.
- F. Fillers:

1. Four standard melamine colors with $\frac{3}{4}$ " particle board core.
- G. Perforations:
1. Holes drilled in door, sides, or backs for additional ventilation
- H. Make door knobs and coat rods available.
